All Applications Must Be Received Prior To June 20, 2018.

- 1. Applicant must be a dependent child of an active or a retired member of the Suffolk County Police Conference.
- 2. Applicant must either be a senior in high school planning to enter, or is a full time college student attending any approved two or four year college in the United States.
- 3. Post graduate courses are not eligible for scholarship awards.
- 4. There will be (12) scholarship selected at the SCPC June 20, 2018 Open Meeting.
